





During regular business hours (8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. EST), any election-related action electronically filed with the Clerk will be assigned to one of the eleven standard circuit civil divisions in Tampa according to the assignment procedures in Administrative Order S-2019-047 (Circuit Civil Division). If necessary, the assigned judge will establish an expedited schedule for further filings and hearings.

During non-business hours on Election Day and Night (5:01 p.m. Tuesday, November 3rd through 7:59 a.m. Wednesday, November 4th, 2020), any application requesting emergency relief in an election-related case will be immediately assigned to Administrative Judge Rex M. Barbas via a representative of the clerk's office. Petitioners must contact Kathleen Rocamora, Senior Director of the Clerk of the Circuit Court's Civil Court Processing Center, (813) 307-7164 or (cell) (813) 323-7110, simultaneous with e-filing the application requesting emergency relief.
